Information & Referral Discover community resources and get referrals to access other local services.

Independent Living Skills Learn the skills needed to live as independently as possible such as learning bus routes, time management, and budgeting.

Advocacy ADA education for parents and youth, including the legal impact of transitioning to higher education or employment.

Employment Readiness Get guidance with writing resumes, cover letters, interviewing, disclosing a disability, and asking for reasonable accommodation.

Social Security and Benefits Applications Receive guidance and support with benefits applications.
